I graduated from Manchester University in 1985 and became a partner at St. George's Dental Practice in 1986.

Since qualifying as a General Dental Practitioner, I have completed a 2 year postgraduate course in orthodontics (teeth straightening) at Manchester University and Preston Hospital and currently offer orthodontic services 5 sessions a week.

I have been placing and restoring dental implants since 1995, my studies in implantology and cosmetic dentistry have taken me to America, Germany, France and the United Kingdom. I have recently trained in the administration of cosmetic procedures to eliminate facial lines using botulinium toxin (Botox) and derma fillers (restylane).

I offer inhalation sedation for the nervous patient and I welcome referrals for smile makeovers, implantology, sedation and cosmetic procedures.

I am a member of the British Dental Association, the British Orthodontic Society, the British Academy of Aesthetic Dentistry, the Association of Dental Implantology, the Dental and Facial Aesthetic Association and the Society of Dental Anaesthetists.
